

## QMobile Webinar Q&A

**Question:**

*Does the dictation allow for tagging a certain area of the note?*

- No, current dictation in QMobile will allow anyone who has given access to the microphone on their iPhone to do reviews on individual exams.
- This is free flow review comments from doctor looking at patient exams and data and give actions to the users or comment on exam.
- If any smaller practice is looking to bring these into exams, they can follow liquid links [device dictation] workflow in template with refreshing their Exams in QEMR.

*Will this be available to Android users in the future?*

- Yes! Android capability will most likely be available by Q2 of 2020.

*Where do the Acknowledgement Notes to Patient or Internal Comments from QMobile appear in the EMR?*

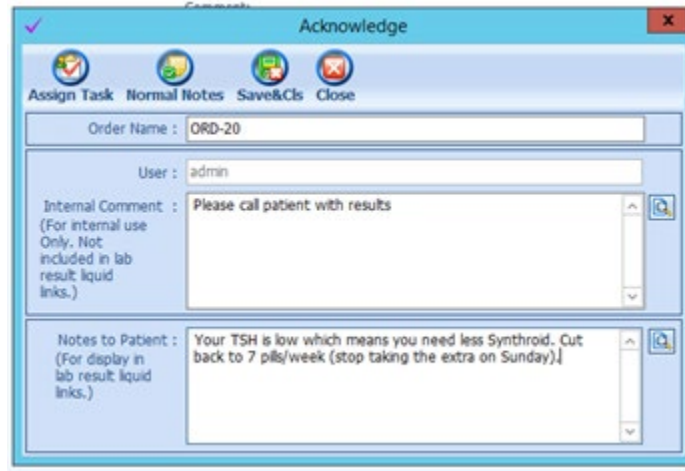
**What Acknowledgement looks like in QMobile:**
